A journey comes to an end... to open new ones



FINAL MEETING IN BOLOGNA AND FULLY ACCESSIBLE PUBLIC CLASS

After eighteen months of dedication, dialogue, and co-design, the *All for Everyone* project has come to its ends. On May 8–9, the *Fondazione Gualandi a favore dei sordi* in Bologna hosted the final meeting, bringing together all the European partners involved: the *Colegio Gaudem* (Madrid) and the *Lietuvos kurčiųjų ir neprigirdinčiųjų ugdymo centras* (Vilnius).

The meeting provided an opportunity to review the outcomes of the project activities, evaluate the materials produced, and define future perspectives. Each partner shared their local experiences, insights, and results, contributing to an increasingly clear and collective vision: making Kundalini Yoga truly accessible to all.

THE FINAL TEST: A FULLY INCLUSIVE OPEN CLASS

The most meaningful moment was the fully accessible public Kundalini Yoga class, organized in Bologna and open to both deaf and hearing participants. This experience brought to life all the work developed throughout the project: visual materials, LIS interpreters, clear visual communication, and an inclusive environment attentive to everyone's needs.



THE EMOTION OF THE PARTICIPANTS

The active participation and feedback received confirm that this project made a real impact: many deaf participants felt welcomed and truly involved. The open class was not just a technical demonstration, but a deep, human moment of exchange, listening, and connection.

We know that inclusion is built step by step – through listening, dedication, and collaboration. And this is just the beginning.

With the presentation of the official guidelines and accessible materials, the *All for Everyone* project comes to an end, but its impact will continue to grow. Our goal is now to disseminate the results and seek participation in a broader European initiative aimed at training yoga teachers to lead inclusive classes.
